# Biography

**Dr Daniel Mo** is an Associate Professor at The Hang Seng University of Hong Kong. He is an active researcher and a principal investigator of several research projects. During his postgraduate studies, he gained the best teaching assistant excellent award and the Sir Edward Youde Memorial Fellowship twice. In 2011, he was certified as a Six Sigma Black Belt to provide training for managers.
